BYLAWS FOR THE FLORIDA ANTIQUE TRACTOR CLUB, INC.

ARTICLE V

OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS:

SECTION 1. Officers of The Florida Antique Tractor Club, Inc. shall be: President, 1<sup>st</sup> Vice President of Antique Tractors, 2<sup>nd</sup> Vice President of Garden Tractors, Secretary, Treasurer.

SECTION 2. There shall be (4) Directors, who shall be assigned specific areas of responsibility one area being that of Historian. IE: Membership, registration, show coordinator etc. but not limited to these areas.

SECTION 3. The Board of Directors will consist of 5 Officers and 4 Directors. No business can be conducted without at least 5 (five) members of the board present.

SECTION 4. Officers and Directors may be elected by a majority vote of the active members present or by proxy at the first regular meeting in January, annually.

SECTION 5. Removal of Officers and Directors: Officers and Directors may be removed from their elected position by a majority vote of the Board of Directors Determination of removal shall be: miss 3 or more consecutive meetings without being excused by the President or conduct unbecoming an Officer.

SECTION 6. Vacant positions of Officers or Directors may be filled by a majority vote of remaining Officers and Directors.

SECTION 7. President will preside at all regular and special meetings, call for special meetings, appoint all committees as directed by the Board of Directors or represent the Club at public events and meetings, be a co-signature on the Club checks, and shall provide all active members with a list of Club goals and objectives at the next regular meeting following his/her election.

SECTION 8. 1<sup>st</sup> Vice-president shall assume all duties in the absence of the President, be a co-signature on Club checking account, coordinate public service activity each year, and any other duties the president or Board of Directors may assign.

2<sup>nd</sup> Vice-President shall oversee matters involving the Garden Tractors, may be a signer on the Club checking account, and any other duties the President or Board of Directors may assign.

SECTION 9. Secretary shall record, transcribe and present minutes of all regular and special meetings. These minutes shall be presented at each regular meeting and will include the previous regular meeting and any special meeting held between regular meetings. In addition, the Secretary will be responsible for all Association written correspondence and any other duties the president or Board of Directors may assign.

SECTION 10. Treasurer shall be responsible for all financial transactions involving the Club at each regular meeting, present current balance of all Club's accounts and amounts of deposits and withdraws during he past month, be a co-signature on the Club checks, and any other duties the President or Board of Directors may assign.

SECTION 11. Historian shall keep scrapbook of pictures, papers and other items that will show how the Club history from its start, and any other duties the President or the Board of Directors may assign.

SECTION 12. Each Director will be responsible for development of activities in their respective areas, reporting at each regular meeting, and any other duties the President or the
